DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Directions from 1-25/Fort Collins

- Take exit 269B to Hwy 14 West
- Drive 3 miles west on Hwy 14 (you'll follow 14/287 through much of town)
- Turn RIGHT onto Riverside. Drive .6 miles, Riverside becomes Jefferson. Continue .4 miles
- Turn RIGHT onto College Ave./Hwy 14/US 287. Drive 3.6 miles
- Stay LEFT onto US 287B towards LaPorte. Continue 2.6 miles.
- Turn LEFT onto Rist Canyon Rd. (Look for Vern's Diner & Gas on the right).
- Drive 12 miles up the mountain, approximately 20-25 minutes.

AT THE TOP OF THE MOUNTAIN

- Turn left on CR-41. There will be an orange parcel box and a row of mailboxes .
- Drive about a mile to get to the first gate (stay right, going left will take you to the county cell towers)
- Stay on this road, you will pass through another gate/cattle guard.
- PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY.
- You will pass through Circle D (the old Tip Top) Ranch. There are several water bars (dirt road speed bumps). PLEASE USE CAUTION AND *DRIVE SLOWLY*.

• Turn left at the gate/cattleguard after Circle D ranch.

There is an automatic gate; wait for the gate to open before proceeding through.

• Continue down the road until you reach a large fork in the road. There will be a large Buckhorn Camp sign and you will veer right, heading into camp! *CONTINUE DRIVING SLOWLY*.

RULES OF THE DIRT ROAD

• DRIVE SLOWLY

Many sections of the road are one-car wide and there are plenty of wildlife to be aware of. All of the property you drive through is private property and we need to be respectful and courteous as we pass through.

• UPHILL TRAFFIC HAS THE RIGHT OF WAY

If you see a car coming uphill, do your best to pull over and allow them to pass.

• STAY ON THE ROAD

Again, all property is private once you are on the dirt road. Please do not exit your vehicle until you have reached camp.

• DRIVE SLOWLY

It never hurts repeating! The max speed limit on our road is 15 MPH. We highly recommend 10 MPH. The slower you drive, the better it is for your vehicle, and our road.
